- March 28—"Caiaphas, the High Priest" (Michael Purdy)

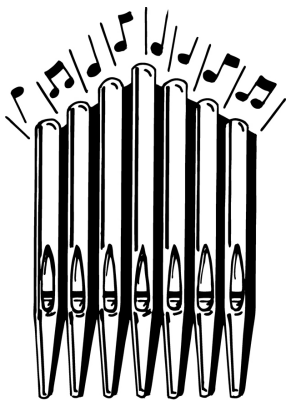
### Sock Hop (for all ages!) Planned to Help Van Fund

## ORGAN NEWS

### Organ Delivery Delayed

Unforeseen circumstances have led to a delay in the delivery of the organ. The driver contracted by Bybee Organ Works picked up the organ slated for Fairview on Monday, March 1<sup>st</sup> in the Chicago area. It was to have been delivered here March 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup>, but so far has not shown up.

An investigation is ongoing by several authorities to determine what has happened. The church is being kept apprised of any new information or developments. Assurances have been provided that Bybee Organ Works has insurance to cover any losses if needed. The matter was discussed in-depth at the General Board meeting March 8<sup>th</sup>. If you have further questions, you may contact one of the Board members or Dave Bennett, Trustee, who has been designated as the congregation's liaison to Bybee Organ Works and investigating authorities until this matter is resolved.

## CLASSIC CROWD TRIPS

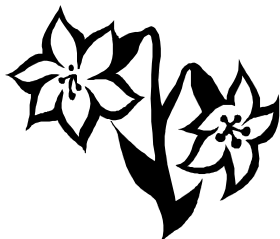
Classic Crowd have the following trips scheduled:
