## REMINDER

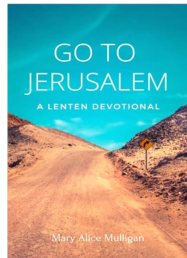
Due to current COVID guidelines, Fairview will not be having an Ash Wednesday Service this year.

Fairview has free copies of this Lenten Devotional while they last.

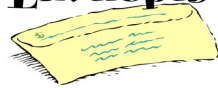
Copies are available on the Welcome Table & the table just down from the Chapel. Or, please feel free to call the office if you would like to come by & pick up a copy.
