




It is with sincere sympathy that we announce that Eileen A., mother of Sandy & Linda A., passed away May 26th. Services have taken place.

3. Serving table inside as in the past but move "sugar and cream" table farther away from the serving table so we don't bunch up at the end of the serving table.

fortable.

- 5. Cookies and donuts are to be served by Koffee Klatch host. The congregation members will let the host know which cookies or donut they want and the host will put them on a napkin and hand them to that person.
- 6. <u>Coffee served as we have in the past.....host serving</u>. We usually have had the host place the filled coffee cups on the table under "regular" or "decaf". The cups are then just picked up off the table.
- 7. <u>Sugar, sugar subs and cream will be in individual packets</u>. In the past we have just put them in a basket but suggesting we spread them out on tabletop and let people pick them up. Same on spoons, spread them out rather than all in a basket.
- 8. For inside Fairview's property, current Fairview mask guidelines to be followed, if you are having refreshments on the patio, it's your choice regarding masks.
- 9. When cleaning up, there is an additional sanitizing product available to use. Please look over the instructions posted by Property on the procedure which is posted next to sanitizing product on the cart in the Fellowship Hall.
