 Look! I'm doing a new thing;
 now it sprouts up; don't you recognize it?
 I'm making a way in the desert,
 paths in the wilderness..." (Isaiah 43:1-4, 19 CEB)

This scripture is about God transforming the people God has called. Do you see the new thing? Do you believe you're being called? How are you responding? —Pastor Kassie



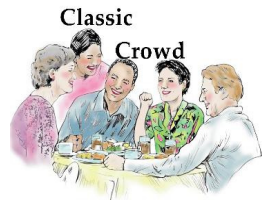

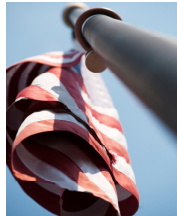


Bonnie M. has a new address (her phone # is the same).

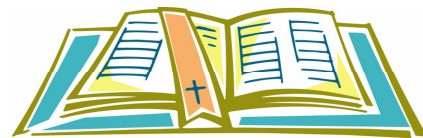

As of the printing of this newsletter, the new surface should be poured. After it has been poured, compacted, and smoothed, it can be driven on rather quickly after a short period of drying. It would be much the same as the city does repairing streets.

On the day the pouring has been completed, any one who needs to park their car for some length of time should park on the grass. There should be access points available.
