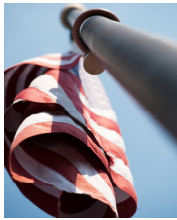

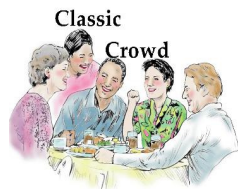
It's time to celebrate!! How about Christmas in July at Fairview?

To date, that represents approx. 97,500 plastic bags made into those mats (avg. of 500 plastic bags per mat, depending on the stitch size).

Congratulations to all involved with the whole process of taking donated/used plastic bags, cutting them into strips, rolling the strips into plarn, using the plarn to crochet them into mats & then getting the mats ready to be distributed to the homeless.
