Fairview Beloved,

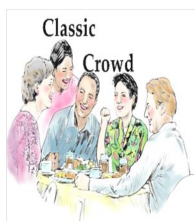

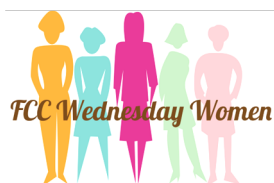

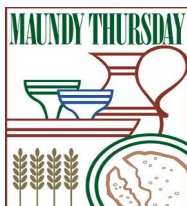
Easter Breakfast will
