

On November 28th we blessed and dedicated the monetary donations the Congregation gave for the Northland Christmas Store.

The total amount delivered to the Christmas Store on November 30th was \$2,800.00. The breakdown was \$2,050.00.00 donated by the Congregation and \$750 donated from Fairview's Missions Department.

The above amount exceeds the amount Fairview donated last year & is more than enough for all of the gift cards for the children ages 15-18 years old. The remainder will be used to purchase food and toys.

The number of Fairview volunteers that will be working this year at the Store are 10 people who will be covering 4-hour shifts.

The store will be serving 189 families for a total of 803 people plus 210 homebound seniors.

As always FCC came through over and above.
